[Gambling Commission survey data on public perceptions of gambling](#)

UK Gambling Commission. (2010).

This paper provides information on public perceptions of gambling. It sets out the findings from questions asked through omnibus surveys conducted by ICM Research. This is the first time this information has been published. Questions monitoring public perceptions of gambling were initially piloted in the surveys from June 2006. These questions were subsequently revised to provide more detail

(by distinguishing between gamblers and non-gamblers, and identifying which crimes respondents associated with gambling), to improve respondent understanding and to increase the accuracy of responses.
